## Seminarweek March 17–21, 2014

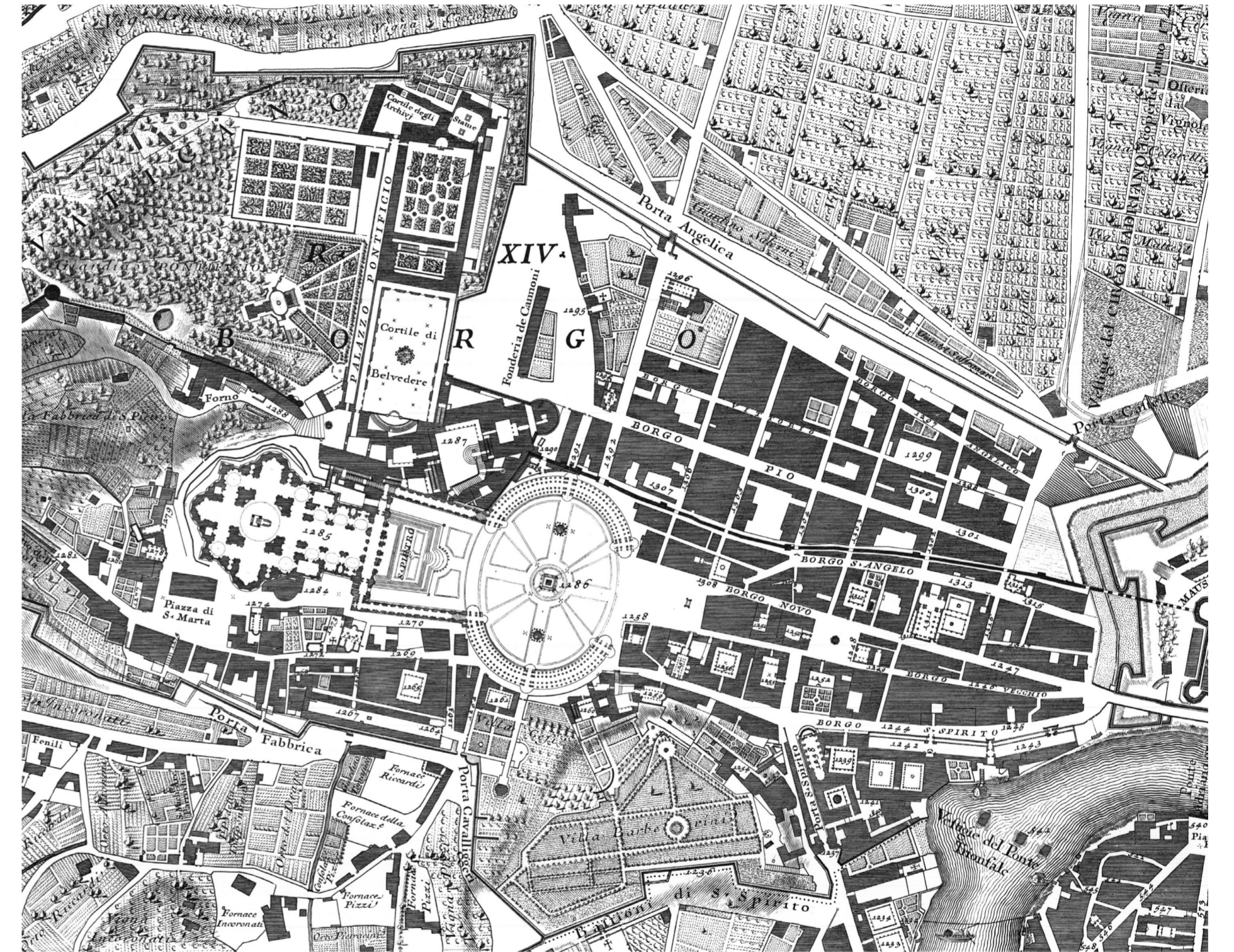
